BACKGROUND:

On October 16, 2019 the HEDC held a public hearing to discuss and thereafter approve funding for the construction of a spray park / splash pad at the Helotes Fitness Park and Disc Golf Course and construction of new sidewalks along Riggs Rd. from (OLG) to FM. 1560 and Along Old FM. 1560 From FM. 1560 to Helotes City Hall.

The postponement of the two projects and reallocation of those funds to support emergency relief efforts for the Helotes business community through the Small Business Assistance Grant Program was approved by HEDC on March 3, 2021 the by Resolution 21-003 and approved by City Council on March 25, 2021 by Resolution 21-004.

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF HELOTES ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ("EDC") APPROVING THE CANCELATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SPRAY PARK / SPLASH PAD AT THE HELOTES FITNESS PARK AND DISC GOLF COURSE AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SIDEWALKS ALONG RIGGS RD. FROM OUR LADY GUADALUPE CATHOLIC CHURCH (OLG) TO F.M. 1560 AND ALONG OLD F.M. 1560 FROM F.M. 1560 TO HELOTES CITY HALL; REALLOCATE THOSE FUNDS TO THE EDC GENERAL RESERVE FUND; INCORPORATING RECITALS; DECLARING A PUBLIC PURPOSE; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE, AND TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, On October 16, 2020, the HEDC held a public hearing to discuss funding "Projects" as defined by Texas Local Govt. Code Chapter 505 *Type B Corporations; and*

WHEREAS, those "Projects" were approved by HEDC Board of Directors to include the construction of a spray park / splash pad at the Helotes Fitness Park and Disc Golf Course and construction of new sidewalks along Riggs Rd. from OLG to FM. 1560 and along Old F.M. 1560 from F.M. 1560 to Helotes City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the HEDC Board of Directors budgeted between \$375,000.00 and \$475,000.00 to complete the abovementioned "Projects"; and

WHEREAS, On February 17, 2021, the HEDC Board of Directors approved a Resolution to postpone said projects to support a Small Business Assistance Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the HEDC Board of Directors have determined the need to cancel the projects and reallocate those funds to the HEDC general reserve fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HELOTES ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION THAT:

SECTION 1: Recitals. The HEDC Board of Directors hereby find as facts the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution and hereby incorporates them herein by reference.

SECTION 2: Authorization. THE HEDC Board of Directors hereby authorizes and directs the Executive Director to take all necessary steps to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Resolution. The HEDC Board of Directors hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared void.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately after its passage and approval.
